- Attend monthly (apart form August and December) meetings at the Village Hall
- Liaise with Cherwell District Council and Oxfordshire County Council particularly regarding roads
- Comment on Planning Applications
- Represent the Parish Council at the Village Hall Committee
- Look after both playing fields
- Manage the maintenance contract for grass cutting and parish council owned trees
- Co-ordinate neighbourhood watch and liaise with Thames Valley police
- Monitor footpaths and issues with dogs
- Look after the defibrillator at the village hall
- Produce Mollington Matters

Councillors share these jobs and are helped by our Clerk.

It's good fun and you are helping all residents by volunteering to become a Councillor.

Mollington Educational Fund


